RUNWAY 06R-24L - PERIODIC RUNWAY CLOSURES FROM OCTOBER 29 TO NOVEMBER 7, 2018

In order to keep its facilities to reliability and safety standards, Aéroports de Montréal has undertaken ground surface repair work and replacement of concrete slabs in the holding bay of runway 06R. The work is being done from October 29 to November 7.

During this period, the use of runway 06R-24L is modified as follows:

From Monday, October 29, to Friday, November 2:

- From 5 a.m. to 8 a.m.: Northeasterly winds runway 06R is available for take off (see Map 1) / Southwesterly winds - no operation on the runway (see Map 2)
- From 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.: Runway closed (see Maps 2 and 3)


From Friday, November 2 - 10 p.m. to Monday, November 5 - 3 p.m.:


Runway closed (see Maps 2 and 3)


From Tuesday, November 6, to Wednesday, November 7:

- From 5 a.m. to 8 a.m.: Northeasterly winds runway 06R is available for take
 off (see Map 1) / Southwesterly winds no operation on the runway (see Map
 2)
- From 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.: Runway closed (see Maps 2 and 3)

Residents of Dorval north, Pointe-Claire, Saint-Laurent north and Ahuntsic-Cartierville may observe an increase of overflights in their areas.
