NORTH RUNWAY - CLOSED FROM APRIL 23 TO THE END OF FALL 2021


With the objective of ensuring optimal management of the use of our facilities during this pandemic, ADM Aéroports de Montréal plans to operate on a single runway until the next Winter period.

The north runway (06L/24R) will therefore be closed from April 23 till the end of the Fall period 2021.

During this period, flights will be assigned to the south runway (06R-24L) whose fligth plaths fly over south Dorval, south Saint-Laurent, Town of Mount-Royal, Villeray-St-Michel-Parc-Extension, Rosemont-La-Petite-Patrie.

Air activities continue to be greatly impacted by the pandemic. The average number of flights per day remains between 120 and 150 flights compared to 500 to 600 in 2019, and there is no planned increase for summer 2021.

The <u>Indicators</u> section on the website displays interactive inditors on air movements at YUL, including the total number of movements, movement distribution by runways, by airlines and aircraft types. You will also find Complaints Indicators as well as the 2020 Annual Report on Soundscape.



<u>WebTrak</u> displays, almost in real time, flight paths, aircraft type and altitudes, as well as the noise levels recorded at noise monitoring stations, and offers the possibility to easily file a noise complaint. Additionally, WebTrak contains messages on situations that affect runway assignements (weather conditions, short-term runway closures, construction, etc.)
