




A. INDICATORS - SUMMER 2016

NOISE COMPLAINT STATISTICS











Runway Use Statistics - May 2016 (night/day combined)




Runway Use Statistics - June 2016 (night/day combined)






Runway Use Statistics - July 2016 (night/day combined)



Runway Use Statistics - August 2016 (night/day combined)






B. SUMMARY OF NIGHT FLIGHTS - SUMMER 2016

The summer 2016 summary of night flights (May to August) is presented to the Committee. 236 ad-hoc exemptions were granted for the summer of 2016. 7 exemption requests were refused (files were transmitted to Transport Canada).

ADM continues to rigorously evaluate every request for exemption. It is noted that the restricted operation hours apply only to flights operated with an aircraft weighing more than 45,000 kg and that only these flights are required to submit an exemption request.





C. CONSTRUCTION WORK - SUMMER 2016

Runway 06R-24L has been closed since October 24. Operations at its full length are scheduled to resume on November 1, if weather conditions are favourable. A newsletter will be sent to citizens. This newsletter is distributed via e-mail to all citizens who request it, to elected officials, and to the committee members. Copies are also posted on the ADM website.

An overview of work planned for the summer of 2017 will be presented at the next committee meeting, in December.
