This is a new step in this important expansion project for the Montréal-Trudeau airport site. ADM is aiming to rebuild two major infrastructures in front of the airport terminal, namely the multi-level parking lot and the drop-off and pick-up area. Added to this is the construction site for the REM station which will be connected underground to the terminal.
