


### A. YEARLY INDICATORS - 2017

- 277 people filed 543 noise complaints in 2017
  - 14% decrease of complainants compared to 2016 when 322 people had filed 718 complaints
  - 24% decrease of complaints compared to 2016
  - 27% of the complaints were filed by 3 complainants.


### Construction work in 2017:

- Runway 06L-24R:
  - o Intermittent daytime and nightime closures throughout the year.
- Runway 06R-24L:
  - o Intermittent daytime and nightime closures throughout the year.
- Runway 10-28:
  - o Intermittent closures from January to April then closed from May to December.







## MOTIVE OF DISTURBANCE - 2017 MONTRÉAL-TRUDEAU AIRPORT




## Number of aircraft movements / passengers:

## Montreal Pierre-Elliot-Trudeau International Airport (YUL) 2004-2017







## Flight movements - Traffic today:




- Aircraft +45,000 kg (Airbus, Boeing)
- Aricraft -45,000 kg (CRJ, Dash-8, general aviation)

















## Exemptions – Year 2017:

In 2017, 966 ad-hoc exemptions we granted compared to 805 in 2016.


Factors that contributed to the increase:


- Hurricane Irma evacuation flights
- Lightning alerts
- Ice rain episodes
- Major snow storm in March 2017
- 44 exemption requests were refused
- 25 infraction cases were transmitted to Transport Canada compared to 20 in 2016.





## Runway Use Statistics - Year 2017 vs 2016








## B. ANNUAL LEQ - 2017

Localisation of the noise monitoring terminals (NMT):





The Leq average noise levels recorded at the noise-monitoring stations are presented. There are three types of report: total noise (all noise sources) aircraft noise, and community noise (train, truck and other noise not related to aircraft movements). The -21 dB(A) noise-attenuation factor due to home insulation, used by the World Health Organization (WHO), must also be considered.





## C. OVERVIEW OF CONSTRUCTION WORK - SUMMER 2018

- Beginning to mid-March intermittent closures of runway 06L-24R
- Mid-March reopening of runway 10-28
- Mid-March to the end of June Taxiway of runway 06L-24R closed the runway remains operational
- Beginning of July to November runway 10-28 closed
