

EXPANSION OF THE ATA: GOOD NEWS FOR AIR TRANSPORT

Montréal, January 25, 2018 – Aéroports de Montréal wishes to note that an agreement has been reached between the Hon. Marc Garneau, Canada’s Minister of Transport, and his Israeli counterpart, Yisrael Katz, which expands the air transport agreement between Canada and Israel.

“Aéroports de Montréal is delighted with this new agreement, which opens new options by adding seven weekly flights between our two countries. Since Montréal-Trudeau is experiencing significant growth, these new flights offer development possibilities that will be positive for the Montréal community,” said Philippe Rainville, CEO of Aéroports de Montréal.

These seven weekly flights are in addition to the 12 flights per week currently provided for in the air agreement.
