PARTICIPATE TO THE CONSULTATION

Soundscape management is a priority for ADM Aéroports de Montréal. It aims to mitigate the noise impacts of air operations and to maintain a harmonious cohabitation with neighbouring communities.

In 2019, ADM drew up an action plan to optimize soundscape management. ADM hired Helios, a firm with expertise in this area, to identify and analyze best practices at 30 comparable international airports.

The 2019-2023 Soundscape Management Action Plan is composed of some 20 actions in eight categories:

- 1. Complaints Management
- 2. Nighttime Operations
- 3. Encouragement for the Use of Quieter Aircraft
- 4. Noise Abatement Procedures (landing and takeoff)
- 5. Noise Measurement and Soundscape Reports
- 6. Land Planning
- Relationships with Neighbouring Communities
 Preferred Runways System

ADM would like to collect comments on the action plan from citizens of YUL Montréal-Trudeau's neighbouring communities. The action plan is part of an online public consultation. We invite you to read the plan and take part in the consultation by clicking here.

The consultation ends on March 31, 2020.
