

Notice is hereby given that effective April 1, 2021:

ADM Aéroports de Montréal will adjust the minimum landing charge for all flights at YUL Montréal-Trudeau International Airport, regardless of aircraft type. The minimum landing charge will now be set at \$216.

ADM Aéroports de Montréal will adjust the landing charge for all-cargo flights as well. The landing charge will now be set at \$12.40/1000 kg<sup>1</sup>.

The specific rate for piston aircraft will be abolished, such that the general charge will now be applied for that type of aircraft.

A fee equivalent to the Airport Improvement Fee, in the amount of \$10 (plus applicable taxes) per seat<sup>2</sup> upon departure, will now be charged for all passenger flights not using the terminal, as well as general aviation at YUL Montréal-Trudeau International Airport.

The increase in landing charges will ensure that the needs of users/customers of airport facilities continue to be met, while all revenues from fees equivalent to the Airport Improvement Fee will support the financing of airport infrastructure.
