

SHORT-TERM CLOSURES - NORTH RUNWAY

In order to maintain its facilities to reliability and safety standards, ADM Aéroports de Montréal is undertaking maintenance work on the north runway (06L-24R) which will require its closure from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Tuesday, March 30, Wednesday, March 31 and Thursday, April 1, 2021.

During these periods, flights will be assigned to the south runway (06R-24L). Residents of south Dorval, south Saint-Laurent, Town of Mount-Royal, Villeray-St-Michel-Parc-Extension could observe an increase of overflights in their area.

Please note that the average number of flights per day is between 120 and 150 flights compared to 500 to 600 in 2019.



Work periods could be modified by weather conditions. This information would be posted on WebTrak. In addition to displaying, almost in real time, flight paths, aircraft type and altitudes, as well as the noise levels recorded at noise monitoring stations, WebTrak contains messages on short-term runway closures or other messages on situations that affect runway assignments.
