ENVIRONMENTAL Policy



Environmental considerations are integral to the operations of Aéroports de Montréal (ADM), from a perspective of environmental protection and sustainable development. Drawing inspiration from its mission, ADM intends to be proactive in environmental matters in the management, operation and development of its airports.



COMMITMENTS

- Ensure compliance with applicable legislation and regulations in matters pertaining to the environment, as well as with other requirements to which ADM subscribes;
- Prevent pollution and minimize the environmental impact caused by both the operation and development of its airport lands, as well as by its procurement activities;
- Conduct environmental monitoring of ongoing operations at its airports;
- » Continue soundscape management efforts;
- » Ensure continuous improvement of its environmental performance;

- Plan the development of its properties in respect of the constraints of surrounding habitats;
- » Co-operate with government authorities, the community and other stakeholders to improve environmental protection practices;
- Raise employee awareness of the importance of environmental protection in the fulfilment of their duties;
- » Act in a manner to maintain its ISO 14001 certification

AREAS FOR IMPROVEMENT

- Improve energy efficiency and reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions that are under its direct control;
- » Apply the 4R principle: reduce at source, re-use, recycle, and recover waste materials;
- » Reduce drinking-water consumption;
- » Protect areas of high ecological value on its lands and mitigate the environmental impacts of projects.
