



Indicators – June to September 2022 YUL Movements




Indicators – June to September 2022 Complaints linked to YUL movements

- 22,647 complaints compared to 24,364 in 2019
- 76% of complaints submitted by 3 people (42% by 1 person)
- 5% of complaints linked to a movement between midnight and 7 a.m.


Indicators – June to September 2022 Complaints linked to YUL movements




From June 1 to September 30:

Indicators – June to September 2022 Complaints – YUL movements






Flights – Restricted Operation Hours May to September 2022

YUL	Number of movements	% of total movements

Aircraft +45,000 kg Arrivals 01:00 – 07:00	376	0.5%

- Newsletter sent July 4 on the extraordinary situation generating delays to airport operations.
- Night of June 16 to 17, several thunderstorms halted operations
- June 21 baggage room shutdown
- July 5 baggage room computer system failure affecting several airports
- Departures: 76 flights took off between 00:00 and 00:05
- Arrivals : 35 flights landed between 01:00 and 01:05

Flights – Restricted Operation Hours May to September 2022

Reasons – One-time exemptions May to September 2022



*Ohers – also includes exemptions for operational delays

Exemptions:

- 783 one-time exemptions
- 44 exemption requests denied

Update – Work on Runways

- October 3 to 14:
 - South runway closed for maintenance work
- October 17 to November 11:
 - North runway closed for the next phase of rehabilitation work
- Spring 2023:
 - North runway will be closed for further rehabilitation work – presentation of the timline at the December meeting
