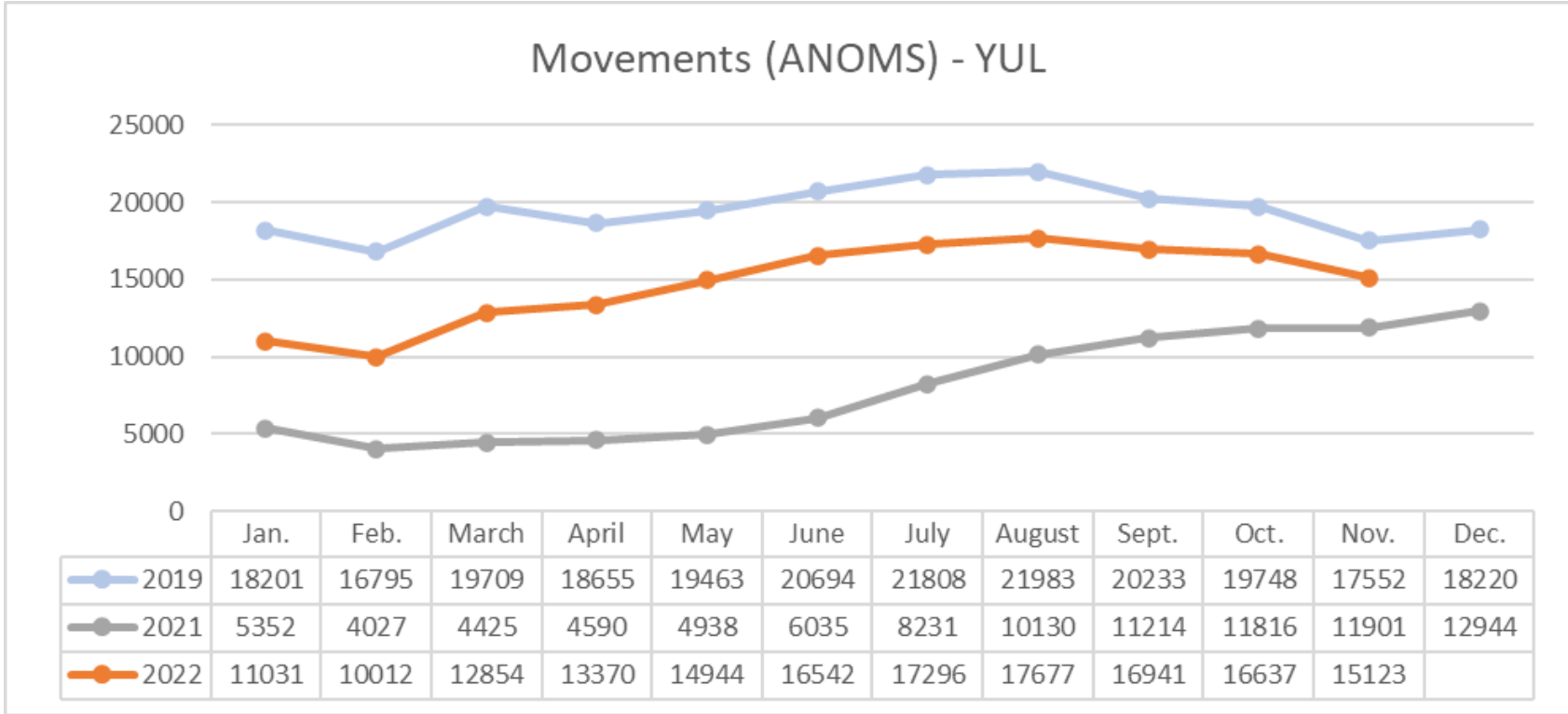

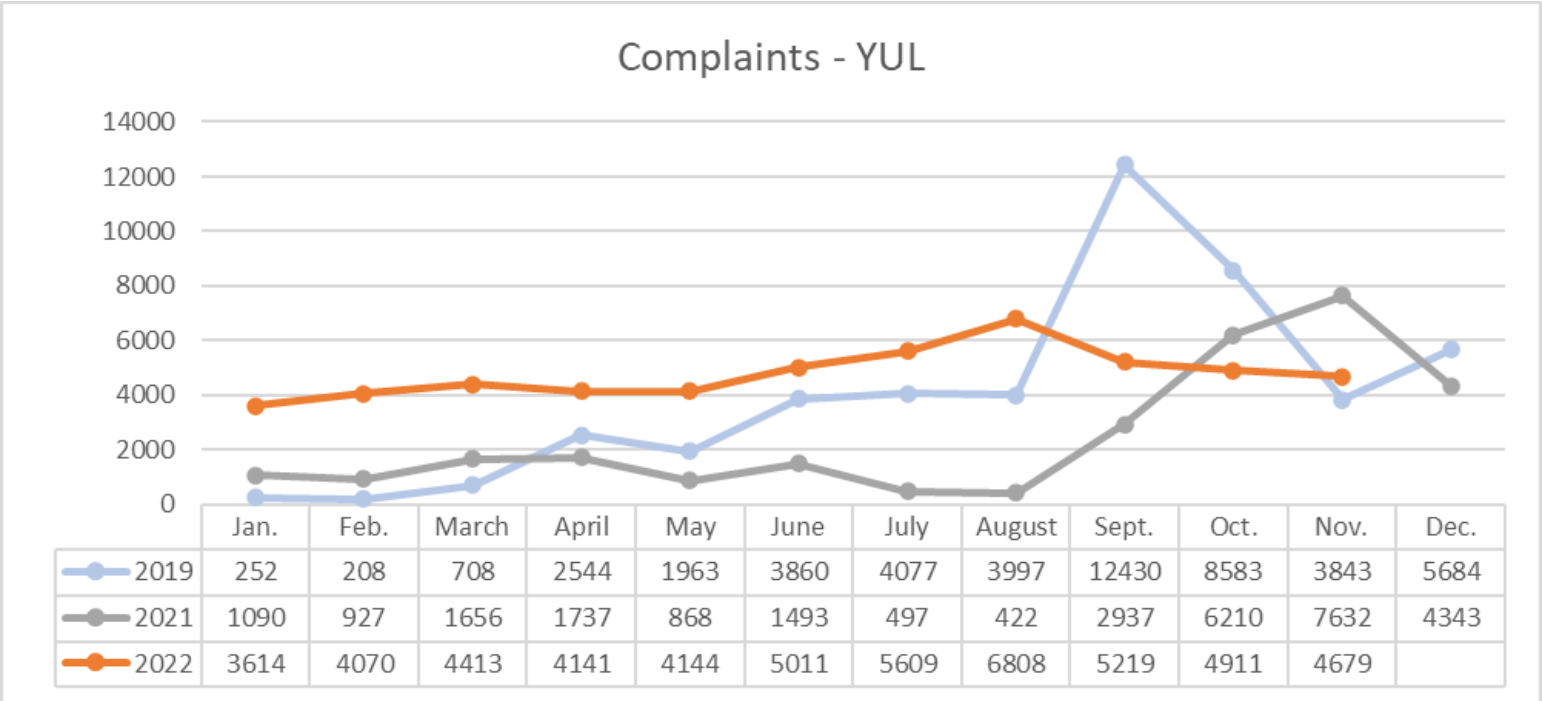

Complaints linked to YUL movements

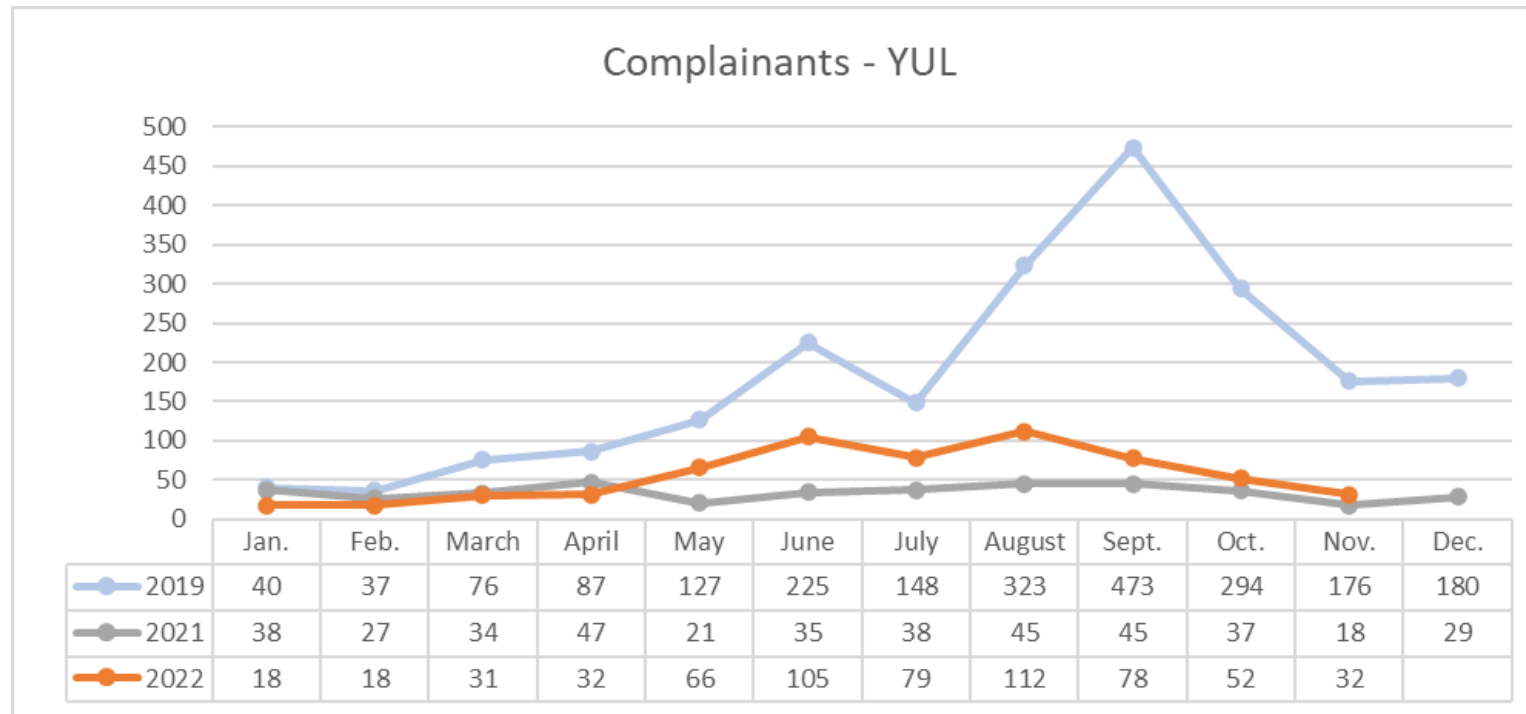


From October 1 to November 30:

- 9,590 complaints compared to 12,426 in 2019
- 78% of complaints submitted by 3 people (41% by 1 person)
- 3% of complaints linked to a movement between midnight and 7 a.m.

Complaints linked to YUL movements

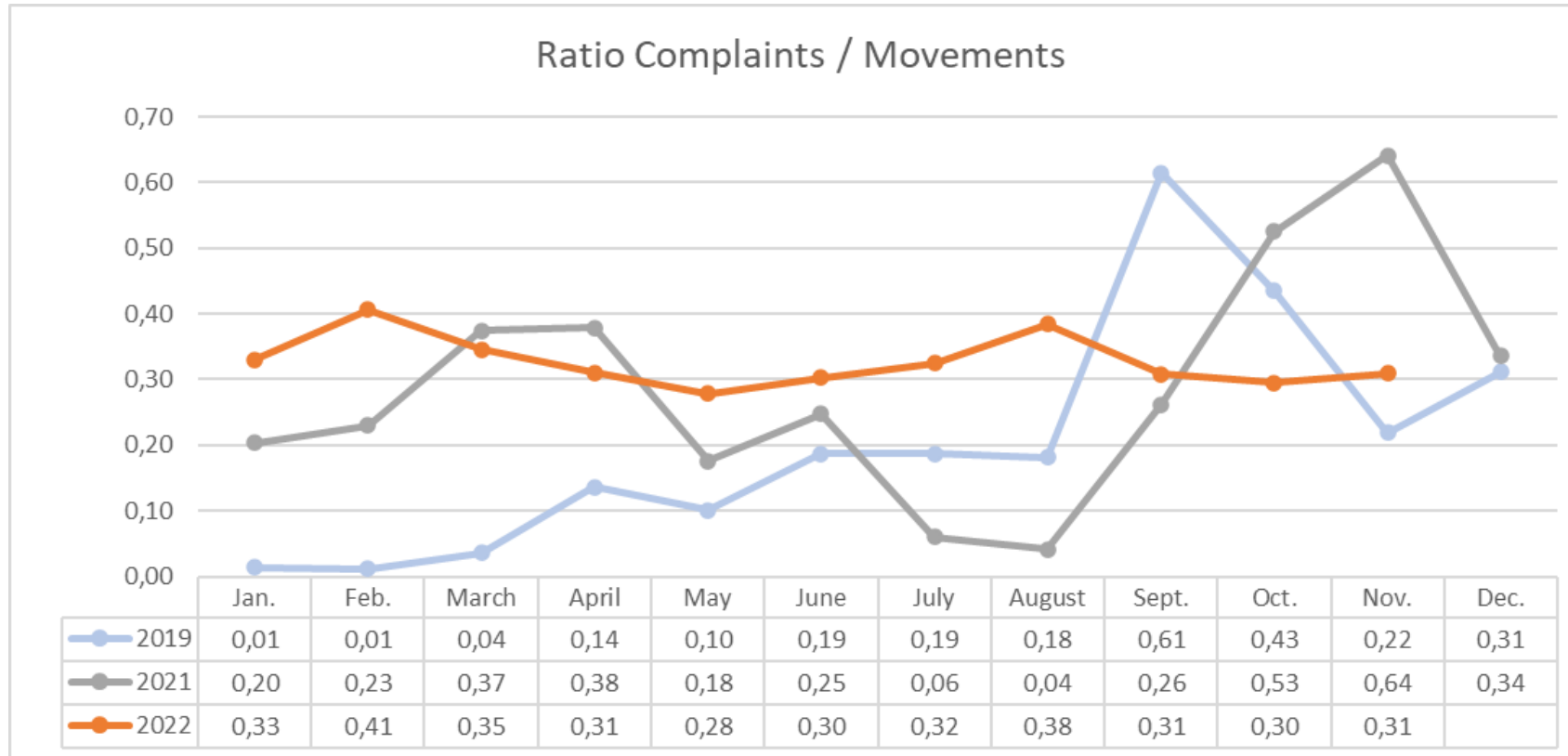


From October 1 to November 30:

- Total of 65 complainants
- Main locations of complainants:
 - 25% Ahuntsic-Cartierville
 - 14% Villeray-St-Michel-Parc-Extension

 - 8% Dorval

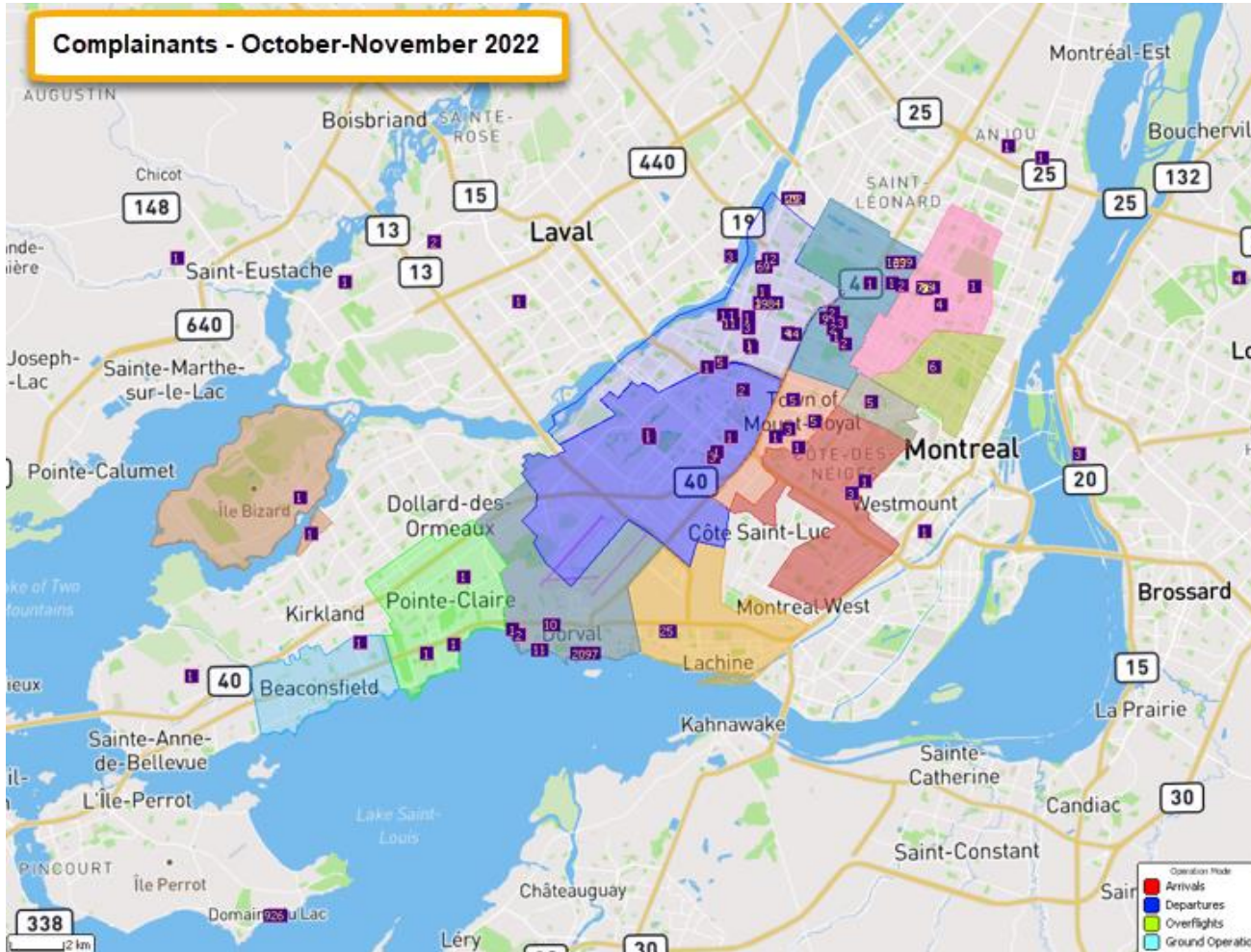

Complaints – YUL movements

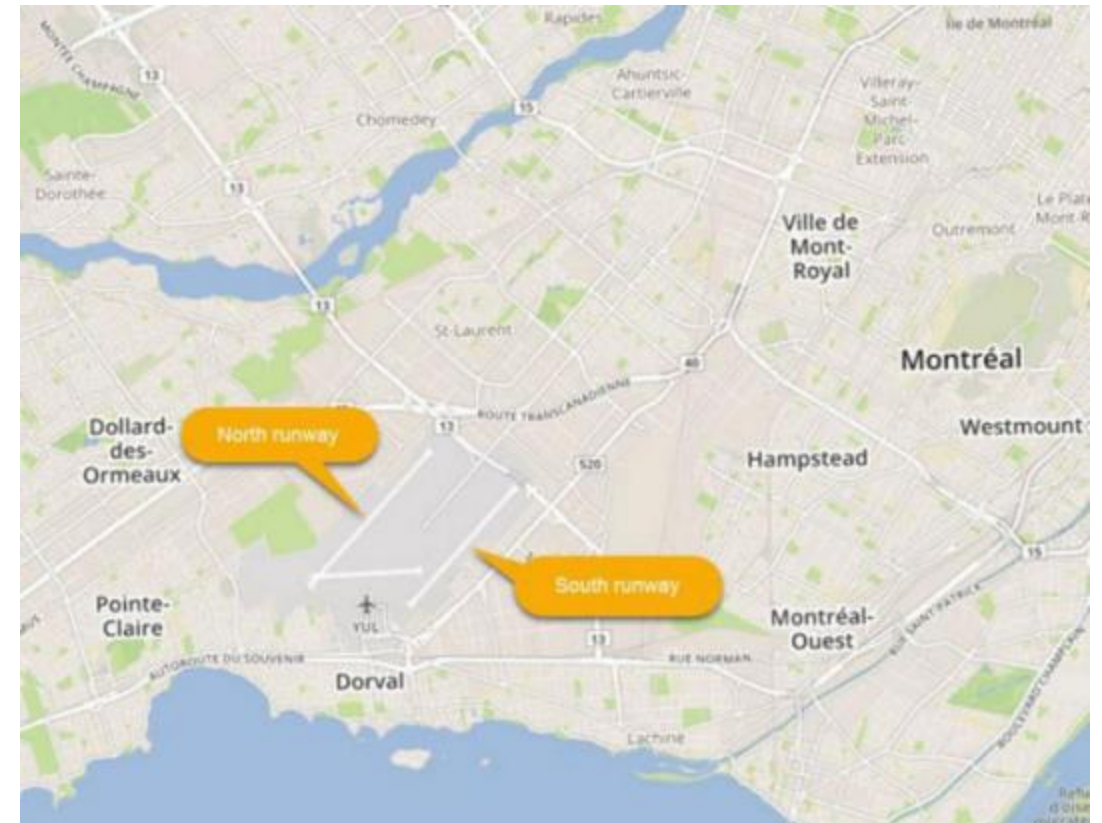


Runway closures:

- South runway closed from October 3 to 14
- North runway closed from October 17 to November 11

Work on Runways - 2023

- Finalization of the rehabilitation of the north runway:
 - From March 13 to June 23 – Runway closed
 - From September 11 to November 17 – Taxiway B closed. Impact: runway remains open however, in northeasterly winds, the north runway will be used for departures and the south runway for arrivals
 - Alternative departure flight paths will remain in use until the end of the work
- South runway:
 - Repair work that will lead to the closure of the runway for a few days – dates to be determined



Work on Runways - 2023

From September 11 to November 17 novembre 2023 – Taxiway B closed (sample of flight paths that will be in place during this period in northeasterly winds)
