ADM intends to be proactive in environmental matters in the management, operation and development of its airports.

GUIDING PRINCIPLES

- » Ensure compliance with applicable environmental legislation and regulations, as well as with other commitments to which ADM subscribes:
- » Prevent pollution and minimize the environmental impact caused by both the operation and development of its airport lands, as well as by its procurement activities:
- » Conduct environmental monitoring of ongoing operations at its airport sites;
- » Continuously improve its environmental performance and adopt ambitious environmental objectives;
- » Operate in a manner as to maintain its ISO 14001 certification;

- » Continue efforts to ensure proper management of the soundscape;
- » Plan the development of its airport sites while respecting the surrounding environmental constraints;
- » Adapt activities and infrastructure to climate change;
- » Collaborate on improving environmental protection with government authorities, the community, as well as with other key actors in the field;
- » Train and educate its employees on environmental protection in the completion of their tasks.







PRIORITY AREAS FOR IMPROVEMENT

- » Improve energy efficiency and reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions, to achieve the net zero objective;
- » Apply the 4R principle: reduce at source, reuse, recycle, and recover residual materials, to achieve the zero-waste objective;
- » Reduce drinking water consumption;
- » Protect and enhance natural environments of high ecological value on its sites to preserve biodiversity.
