

Indicators – September to November 2023 YUL Movements





September to November compared to 2019:

- +8% passengers
- 11% number of movements (ANOMS)
- 20% of movements were operated with new generation aircraft (A220, B738Max, A321Neo, Embraer E295)



Indicators – September to November 2023 Complaints linked to YUL movements




From September to November:

- 17 743 complaints filed by 124 people
- 75% of the complaints for this period were submitted by 3 people.
- 4% of the complaints are linked to an air movement between midnight and 7 a.m.



Indicators – September to November 2023 Complaints linked to YUL movements




From September to November:

- North Runway rehabilitation work:
 - From September 11 to December 1st change of runway use in northeasterly winds (take offs North Runway / landings South Runway)



Indicators – September to November 2023 Complaints – YUL movements






Overview of work in 2024 South Runway (06R-24L)

Start of rehabilitation work of the South Runway:

- Runway closed from March 25 to May 16, 2024
- From May 16 to mid-November, the South Runway will be operational with a reduced length
