# JULY 22 TO NOVEMBER 2016 CONSTRUCTION WORK AT MONTRÉAL-TRUDEAU

### Length of runway 06R-24L reduced for the period of the construction work.

Second phase of the construction work to enlarge the bay of runway 06R.


In order to use runway 06R-24L for propeller aircraft and smaller jets, the runway will remain open during the second phase of the construction work. However, the length of the runway is reduced from July 22 to November 2016.

As in the first phase of the construction (July 12 to July 22), the same areas of Dorval north, Pointe-Claire and Saint-Laurent north will notice an increase in the number of overflights.

Runway assignment will be as follows:


## Southwesterly winds:

- Departures: runways 24R and 28 (larger aircraft) and runway 24L (propeller and small jet aircraft)
- Arrivals: runway 24R (larger aircraft) and runway 24L (propeller and small jet aircraft)



### Northeasterly winds:

- Departures: runway 06L (larger aircraft) and runway 06R (propeller and small jet aircraft)
- Arrivals: runways 06L and 10 (larger aircraft) and runway 06R (propeller and small jet aircraft)



Respect of the work schedule depends mainly on weather conditions.
