CONSTRUCTION WORK ON EASTERN APRON AND DEICING CENTRE FROM MAY 25 TO THE BEGINNING OF OCTOBER 2015


In order to maintain its facilities to reliability and safety standards, Aéroports de Montréal will be undertaking construction work on the eastern apron and the deicing centre from May 25 to the beginning of October 2015.

The work will limit access to runway 06R-24L generating an increase of departures and arrivals on runway 06L-24R from 7 a.m. to 11 p.m., Mondays to Saturdays.


During these periods, residents of Dorval north, Pointe-Claire, Saint-Laurent north and Ahuntsic-Cartierville will observe an increase in the number of flights in their areas.

From Monday to Saturday, between 7 a.m. and 11 p.m., runway assignment will be as follows:

Southwesterly winds:



Northeasterly winds:



Runway 10-28 will be closed from May 25 to the beginning of October.

Respect of the work schedule depends mainly on weather conditions.
